The book is a critical look at the life and works of Antigone Kefala, a poet and prose writer who came to the Antipodes in the early fifties and since 1960 calls Australia home. It comprises a selection of interviews, reviews and essays, giving a fascinating insight into this writer – originally a Greek from Romania. The book aims to stimulate a wide-ranging dialogue on the state of Australian literature and the place within it of writers like Antigone Kefala.

Antigone Kefala's books include *Absence: new and selected poems*; *The Island*; *Alexia*; *Summer Visit: three novellas*; *Sydney Journals* and several others. Four of her works are available in bilingual editions.
